VISA APPLICATION PACK

To find out if you may be able to enter Thailand under the "Visa Exemption Rule" or the "Visa on Arrival Rule" please check download "**V1 General Visa Rules & Regulations**"

If you are not eligible to enter Thailand under either of the above rules it will be necessary for you to apply for a Tourist Visa or Non-Immigrant Visa before entering Thailand

IT IS NOT POSSIBLE TO OBTAIN A VISA IN THAILAND

TOURIST VISAS

Tourist Visas are available with either a single entry or with multiple entries. The single entry visa has a validity of three months from date of issue. The multiple entry visa has a validity of six months from date of issue. Each entry allows a stay of up to 60 days. Nationals of most countries of the world can apply at the Royal Thai Consulate, Hull for a tourist visa with either a single entry or with multiple entries provided they meet the requirements.

Nationals of the following countries must apply for a visa only at the Royal Thai Embassy in London:-

Single Entry Tourist Visa

This visa has a validity of three (3) months from date of issue. This means that you have three months to enter Thailand. You must ensure you enter Thailand no later than the **day before** the ENTER BEFORE date as shown on the visa. Applicants for this visa must submit the following:-

1. Completed Visa Application Form with two recent passport size photographs attached.
2. Passport with minimum 6 months validity at time of entering Thailand and with at least two blank pages for the Visa and for Entry/Exit Stamps.
3. Fee of £25 plus £10 processing charge = total of £35 in **CASH** only.

Multiple Entry Tourist Visa

This visa has a validity of six (6) months from date of issue. This means that you have six months to make your **final** entry into Thailand. You must ensure you make your **final** entry no later than the **day before** the ENTER BEFORE date as shown on the visa.

Applicants for this visa must submit the following:-

1. Completed Visa Application Form with two recent passport size photographs attached.
2. Passport with minimum 6 months validity at time of entering Thailand and with at least two blank pages for the Visa and for Entry/Exit Stamps.
3. Copies of latest 6 months personal bank statements showing minimum of £5,000 continuously throughout the 6 months.
Bank statements must show the visa applicant's name and address.
In the case of joint bank accounts where both account holders are travelling to Thailand
The amount must be minimum £10,000.

4. For children travelling with parents, a copy of each child's birth certificate showing names of parents.
5. Copy of confirmed return or onward air ticket showing the applicant will be exiting Thailand within the validity/terms of the visa.
6. Copy of confirmed reservation for first stay in Thailand (hotel, boarding house, etc) If staying with friends or family who live in Thailand, copy of any recent utility bill for their home.
7. If employed, letter from employer stating how long you have been employed by them and that they are aware you will be travelling to Thailand for a holiday.
or
If Self-Employed, copy of the completed HMRC SA100 Self-Employed Tax Return Form for the latest Tax Year.
or
If retired (any age) and receiving a **Private Pension**, copy of Pension Statement or similar which must show applicant's name and address.
8. Fee of £125 plus £10 processing charge = total of £135 in **CASH** only.

With this visa, on first arriving in Thailand you will pass through Thai Immigration where you will be granted a 60-day stay and will receive a stamp in your passport giving the date you enter (ADMITTED) and the date by which you must exit (UNTIL). It is most important not to stay in Thailand beyond the exit (UNTIL) date or you will be fined when leaving the country. If stopped and questioned by Thai Police and found to be in an overstay situation you could be detained. It is not permitted to stay continuously in Thailand for more than 60 days but if you have a visa with multiple entries you can re-enter for further stays of up to 60 days until your visa expires. At the end of your stay or when your visa ceases to be valid you must exit Thailand.

You are not allowed to enter Thailand on a Tourist Visa for any purpose other than tourism.

NON-IMMIGRANT VISAS

PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL APPLICATIONS FOR NON-IMMIGRANT VISAS MUST BE APPROVED BY THE EMBASSY PRIOR TO BEING ISSUED. THIS PROCESS CAN TAKE UP TO A WEEK.

If your purpose of visiting Thailand is other than tourism you must be in possession of a valid Non-Immigrant Visa before you enter Thailand.

The Non-Immigrant Visa can be granted for the following purposes of visit provided you submit the required substantiating evidence (see V3 EXTRA EVIDENCE REQUIRED FOR NON IMMIGRANT VISAS):-

Category "B"

Conducting business in Thailand as an employee of a non-Thai company (ie a business based outside Thailand).

or

Taking up employment in Thailand with an organisation located in Thailand.

or

Taking up employment as a teacher in Thailand.

or

Undertaking a vocational training course (diving or boxing).

or

Attending a Business Conference/Trade Fair in Thailand.

Category "ED" -

Studying in Thailand (If studying as a Buddhist Monk you must apply for the visa only at the Royal Thai Embassy in London)

or

Taking part in a work study course or observation tour in Thailand

or

Participating in a project or seminar

Category "O"

Married to a Thai national

or

Visiting your child (you must have been granted "**sole custody**" by a Thai Court Ruling)

or

Volunteer work with NGO or Charity (not private organisations)

or

Visiting Thailand as UK pensioner receiving a UK State Pension

FOR DETAILS OF WHAT SUBSTANTIATING EVIDENCE IS REQUIRED IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION FOR A NON-IMMIGRANT VISA PLEASE CHECK VISA DOWNLOAD ENTITLED "V3 EXTRA EVIDENCE FOR NON IMMIGRANT VISAS"

**The Non Immigrant Category "O-A" (Long Stay) Visa
for persons aged between 50 and 65 must be applied for
only at the Royal Thai Embassy in London**

The above Non-Immigrant Visas are available with single entry (validity 3 months) only. Entry must be made within the validity of the visa and allows stay of maximum 90 days. On arrival you are granted a 90-day stay and receive a stamp in your passport giving the date you enter (ADMITTED) and the date when you must exit (UNTIL) unless you have arranged An extension of stay in Thailand.

Please note:-

Visa applications are accepted only from persons who are residing in the UK at the time of application.

Persons who do not have a UK passport which states that they are a BRITISH CITIZEN must provide evidence that they have residence status in the UK such as:-

- a) Valid visa stating they have UK Residency
or
- b) Valid UK Resident Card
or
- c) Valid Council Tax bill in their name.

Visas are dated on the day of issue, they cannot be forward dated.

Visas are issued at the discretion of the Royal Thai Consulate (RTC) and/or the Royal Thai Embassy (RTE).

In the event of a visa not being granted the RTC accepts no liability whatsoever.

In the event of loss (permanent or temporary) or damage to any passport or document while in the possession of the RTC, liability will be limited only to the commercial value of the passport or document taking into account its importance for the purpose it was provided and its period of validity.

The RTC accepts no liability for consequential loss.

Charges for visas are collected as processing fees for the issue of the visa and once the visa has been issued all such fees are non refundable in any circumstances.

Please note that a visa entitles the holder to travel to Thailand and request admission to enter the country.

A visa does not automatically guarantee entry in to Thailand.

Entry is granted only at the discretion of Immigration Officers at the point of entry in to Thailand.

On entering Thailand the actual length of stay shall be determined and granted solely at the discretion of Immigration Officers according to the type and category of visa in possession.

Exiting Thailand within the period of stay granted means forfeiting any remaining days granted for that entry.

FEES & CHARGES

Fees:

**Tourist visa: single entry = £25.00
 multiple entries = £125.00**

Non-Immigrant visa: single entry = £50.00

Charges:

There is a £10 processing charge for all visas issued.

Payment of Fees and Charges to be made in CASH only

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

For most travellers there are no special requirements, however, this is subject to change without notice.

Persons holding passport of or having residence in or having recently visited a Yellow Fever area must present their original International Health Certificate for Yellow Fever at the point of entry into Thailand. Please check Download "O4" for the list of countries with a risk of yellow fever transmission.
