APPLYING FOR A NON-IMMIGRANT CATEGORY “O” VISA ON THE BASIS OF BEING MARRIED TO SOMEONE WHO WORKS IN THAILAND OR IS A CHILD (aged up to and including 19 years) OF SOMEONE WORKING IN THAILAND

ALL INFORMATION PROVIDED IS ON THE BASIS THAT THE APPLICANT WILL BE APPLYING FOR THEIR VISA IN PERSON AT THE ROYAL THAI CONSULATE HULL. PERSONS INTENDING TO APPLY ELSEWHERE FOR THEIR VISA NEED TO CHECK WITH THE RELEVANT AUTHORITY.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE ISSUING OF ALL NON IMMIGRANT VISAS MUST BE AUTHORISED BY THE ROYAL THAI EMBASSY LONDON PRIOR TO BEING ISSUED AND THIS PROCESS CAN TAKE UP TO ONE WEEK. WHEN WE RECEIVE AUTHORITY TO ISSUE WE WILL INVITE YOU TO VISIT US AND THE VISA WILL BE ISSUED USUALLY WITHIN ONE HOUR.

The non-immigrant category O visa is available for persons who are travelling to Thailand on the basis of being married to or are a child of someone who is working in Thailand.

This visa is available with single entry only, it is no longer possible to be granted a multiple entry visa. If wishing to stay longer it will be necessary to visit a Thai Immigration Office near to where you will be staying and enquire about the procedure for extending your stay.

The single entry visa is valid for three months from date of issue and allows a single stay in Thailand of up to 90 days.

So that we can obtain authorisation from the London Embassy to issue this visa it is necessary for the applicant to submit to us all documents relative to this visa therefore we request you to email scanned copies of the following to enquiries@thaiconsul-uk.com:-

1. Copy of the page of your passport with photo and details (passport must have minimum 6 months remaining validity at time of applying for the visa).
2. Completed Visa Application Form with two recent passport size photographs attached.
3. Copy of passport of person working in Thailand – page containing photo and details.
4. Copy of passport of person working in Thailand – page containing relevant B visa.
5. Copies of all pages (not blank ones) of valid Thai Work Permit of person working in Thailand.
or (as applicable)
Copies of all pages of Contract of Employment of person going to be working in Thailand.
6. If married to person working in Thailand, copy of Marriage Certificate.
or
If child of person working in Thailand, copy of Birth Certificate

As soon as we receive authority from the London Embassy we will invite you to visit us so that we can issue the visa and you will need to bring with you the following:-

1. Applicant's passport (minimum 6 months remaining validity and with at least two blank pages for the visa and for entry/exit stamps).
2. Original completed Visa Application Form with two recent passport type photos attached.
3. Visa fee **until 31 March 2019**: £50 (single entry) plus £10 processing charge - total of **£60 in cash only**.
Visa fee **from 1 April 2019**: £60 (single entry) plus £10 processing charge - total of **£70 in cash only**.
