APPLYING FOR A NON-IMMIGRANT CATEGORY “O” VISA FOR THE PARENT OF A CHILD (age up to 19 years) IN EDUCATION IN THAILAND

ALL INFORMATION PROVIDED IS ON THE BASIS THAT THE APPLICANT WILL BE APPLYING FOR THEIR VISA IN PERSON AT THE ROYAL THAI CONSULATE HULL. PERSONS INTENDING TO APPLY ELSEWHERE FOR THEIR VISA NEED TO CHECK WITH THE RELEVANT AUTHORITY.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE ISSUING OF ALL NON IMMIGRANT VISAS MUST BE AUTHORISED BY THE ROYAL THAI EMBASSY LONDON PRIOR TO BEING ISSUED AND THIS PROCESS CAN TAKE UP TO ONE WEEK. WHEN WE RECEIVE AUTHORITY TO ISSUE WE WILL INVITE YOU TO VISIT US AND THE VISA WILL BE ISSUED USUALLY WITHIN ONE HOUR.

The non-immigrant category O visa is available for the parent of a child up to and including 19 years of age who is undertaking an education at a school in Thailand.

This visa is available with single entry only which is valid for three months from date of issue and allows a single stay in Thailand of up to 90 days.

If wishing to stay longer it will be necessary to visit a Thai Immigration Office near to where the child will be staying and enquire about the procedure for extending the stay.

So that we can obtain authorisation from the London Embassy to issue this visa it is necessary for the applicant to submit to us all documents relative to this visa therefore we request you to email scanned copies of the following to enquiries@thaiconsul-uk.com:-

It will be necessary to provide the following supporting documents:-

1. Copy of the page of passport with photo and details (passport must have minimum 6 months remaining validity at time of applying for the visa).
2. Completed Visa Application Form with two recent passport size photographs attached.
3. Copy of supporting letter from Thai School where child will be studying.
4. Copy of Registration Documents and Licence from school.
5. Copy of child's Birth Certificate.
6. Copy of page of child's passport with valid Thai ED visa if applicable.

As soon as we receive authority from the London Embassy we will invite the child and parent to visit us so that we can issue the visa.

When you visit the Royal Thai Consulate at Hull to apply for this visa the applicant or the parent/guardian of the child you will need to bring the following:-

1. Your passport (minimum 6 months remaining validity and with at least two blank pages for the visa and for entry/exit stamps).
2. Two recent passport size photographs as available from a photo booth.
3. Original completed Visa Application Form.
4. Visa fee **until 31 March 2019**: £50 (single entry) plus £10 processing charge - total of **£60 in cash only**.
Visa fee **from 1 April 2019**: £60 (single entry) plus £10 processing charge - total of **£70 in cash only**.
