INFORMATION ABOUT OBTAINING A NON-IMMIGRANT CATEGORY “O” VISA WITH SINGLE ENTRY ONLY ON THE BASIS OF WORKING AS A VOLUNTEER WITH A REGISTERED CHARITY OR A ‘NGO’

A non-governmental organisation (NGO) is an organisation that is neither a part of a government nor a conventional for-profit business. Usually set up by ordinary citizens, NGOs may be funded by governments, foundations, schools, businesses, or private people)

(not with a private organisation)

ALL INFORMATION PROVIDED IS ON THE BASIS THAT THE APPLICANT WILL BE APPLYING FOR THEIR VISA IN PERSON AT THE ROYAL THAI CONSULATE HULL. PERSONS INTENDING TO APPLY ELSEWHERE FOR THEIR VISA NEED TO CHECK WITH THE RELEVANT AUTHORITY.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE ISSUING OF ALL NON IMMIGRANT VISAS MUST BE AUTHORISED BY THE THAI AUTHORITIES PRIOR TO BEING ISSUED AND THIS PROCESS CAN TAKE UP TO ONE WEEK. WHEN WE RECEIVE AUTHORITY TO ISSUE WE WILL INVITE YOU TO VISIT US AND THE VISA WILL BE ISSUED USUALLY WITHIN ONE HOUR.

The non-immigrant category O visa is available for persons who are travelling to Thailand to work as a volunteer with a Registered Charity or NGO.

This visa is available with single entry only, it is no longer possible to be granted a multiple entry visa. If wishing to stay longer it will be necessary to visit a Thai Immigration Office near to where you will be staying and enquire about the procedure for extending your stay.

The single entry visa is valid for three months from date of issue and allows a single stay in Thailand of up to 90 days.

So that we can obtain authorisation from Thailand to issue this visa it is necessary for the applicant to submit to us all documents relative to this visa therefore we request you to email scanned copies of the following to enquiries@thaiconsul-uk.com:-

1. Page of your passport with photo and details (passport must have minimum 6 months remaining validity at time of applying for the visa).
2. Completed Visa Application Form with two passport type photos attached.
3. Letter of invitation from the Charity or NGO.
4. Copy of the Charity/NGO Registration Documents.

PERSONS UNDERTAKING VOLUNTEER WORK WITH A PRIVATE ORGANISATION CAN BE GRANTED ONLY A TOURIST VISA.

As soon as we receive authority to issue the visa we will invite you to visit us and you will need to bring with you the following:-

1. Your passport (minimum 6 months remaining validity and with at least two blank pages for the visa and for entry/exit stamps).
2. Two recent passport size photographs as available from a photo booth.
3. Original completed Visa Application Form with two recent passport size photos attached.
4. Visa fee **until 31 March 2019**: £50 (single entry) plus £10 processing charge - total of **£60 in cash only**.
Visa fee **from 1 April 2019**: £60 (single entry) plus £10 processing charge - total of **£70 in cash only**.
