APPLYING FOR A VISA IN PERSON AT HULL

INFORMATION ABOUT APPLYING FOR THE SINGLE ENTRY TOURIST VISA

ALL INFORMATION PROVIDED IS ON THE BASIS THAT THE APPLICANT WILL BE APPLYING FOR THEIR VISA IN PERSON AT THE ROYAL THAI CONSULATE HULL. PERSONS INTENDING TO APPLY ELSEWHERE FOR THEIR VISA NEED TO CHECK WITH THE RELEVANT AUTHORITY

THIS VISA IS ISSUED IN PERSON ONLY, USUALLY WITHIN ONE HOUR

The Tourist Visa with **SINGLE ENTRY** is valid for 3 months from date of issue and allows a single stay in Thailand of 60 days maximum. If exiting Thailand before the 60th day all remaining days are lost. It may be possible to extend the 60 day stay by a further 30 days by visiting a local Thai Immigration Office. The fee for such extension is THB1900.

The validity of this visa is 3 calendar months from date of issue. The expiry date of the visa shows on the visa sticker as the **ENTER BEFORE** date. So, for example, if the visa was issued on **01 JAN 2019 (DATE OF ISSUE)** the **ENTER BEFORE** date would be **31 MAR 2019**. This means that entry into Thailand must be no later than **30 March 2019**. On entering Thailand you receive a rectangular stamp in your passport stating your date of entry and the **ADMITTED UNTIL** date which should be 60 days after your date of entry. Do **not** remain in Thailand beyond the **ADMITTED UNTIL** date, the consequences can be serious. If exiting Thailand before the 60th day all remaining days are lost. The visa ceases to be valid as of the **ENTER BEFORE** date as shown on the visa and can no longer be used. When you exit Thailand you will receive a triangular stamp in your passport stating your date of exiting Thailand.

HOW TO APPLY FOR THIS VISA AT THE ROYAL THAI CONSULATE, HULL

It is necessary for the applicant or someone nominated by the applicant to visit us **in person**.

To apply for the Tourist Visa with **SINGLE ENTRY** each applicant needs to provide the following:-

1. Completed Visa Application Form with two recent passport type photos attached.
The form is available for completion when visiting us.
2. Passport with minimum 6 months remaining validity at time of travel and with at least two blank pages for the visa and for entry/exit stamps).
For holders of UK passport it must state that they are a BRITISH CITIZEN.
Holders of UK passport which states they are a BRITISH OVERSEAS CITIZEN must obtain a visa for all visits to Thailand even if only for one day.
Holders of all other passports need to check document "**Visa & Info Downloads > V2 – Visa Requirements by Nationality**" which is on our website (www.thaiconsul-uk.com) and must provide evidence that they are entitled to be in the UK (visa or residence card) and also provide evidence of where they live in the UK (utility bill, bank account statement, UK Driving Licence or UK Residence Permit showing their name and address in the UK).

Nationals of the following countries must apply only at the Royal Thai Embassy in London:-

Afghanistan, Algeria, Bangladesh, Cameroon, Central African Republic, People's Republic of China, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Republic of the Congo, Egypt, Equatorial Guinea, Ghana, Guinea, India, Iraq, Iran, North Korea, Lebanon, Liberia, Libya, Nepal, Nigeria, Pakistan, Palestine, Sao Tome and Principe, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Sri Lanka, Sudan, Syria, and Yemen.

3. Two recent passport size photographs as available from a photo booth.
4. Confirmation of travel booking – flight ticket(s).
5. Proof of accommodation in Thailand – either copy of hotel booking for at least the first night or copy of letter from family or friend in Thailand).
6. Copy of latest bank statement or proof of earnings.
7. Confirmation of residence in the UK.
For person who is not a UK national (Council Tax Bill, UK Driving Licence, Bank Statement, Residence Permit or Long Stay UK Visa).
8. Visa fee of £30 + £10 processing charge – **total of £40 payable in CASH ONLY.**

At the end of the 60-day stay (or 90 days if you have obtained a 30-day extension) it will be necessary to exit Thailand. If exiting to a neighbouring country and re-entering Thailand by air or overland without visa as a tourist you will be allowed a stay of either 15 or 30 days according to nationality. However this is entirely at the discretion of Thai Immigration at the time. Please be aware that if entering Thailand by air without a visa you will be allowed a maximum of three 30-day entries within any rolling 6-month period. If entering overland without a visa you are allowed a maximum of two 30-day entries within any rolling 12-month period. Also be aware that the Royal Thai Embassies and Consulates in neighbouring countries may restrict the number of visas they will grant to nationals of countries other than the country where the Royal Thai Embassy / Consulate is located.
