APPLYING FOR A VISA AT HULL

TRANSIT Single (TS)

INFORMATION ABOUT OBTAINING A TRANSIT VISA (Category TS) WITH SINGLE ENTRY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROCEEDING TO OWN COUNTRY

PLEASE NOTE THAT VISAS MUST BE APPLIED FOR IN PERSON ONLY (NOT BY POST) THIS VISA IS ISSUED AT HULL USUALLY WITHIN ONE HOUR

The Transit Visa category 'TS' is available for persons who are travelling to Thailand for the purpose of proceeding to their own country.

To apply for this visa it is necessary for the applicant to provide the following:-

- 1. Passport (minimum 6 months remaining validity and with at least two blank pages for the visa and for entry/exit stamps).
- 2. Two recent passport size photographs as available from a photo booth.
- 3. Completed Visa Application Form.
- 4. Visa fee **until 31 March 2019**: £20 plus £10 processing charge total of **£30 in cash only**. Visa fee **from 1 April 2019**: £25 plus £10 processing charge - total of **£35 in cash only**.
- 5. The evidence of exiting Thailand to their own country within30 days of entry such as copy of onward flight ticket or similar.

ONLY A SINGLE ENTRY VISA WILL BE GRANTED

The **single entry** visa is valid for three months from date of issue and allows a single stay in Thailand of up to 30 days. Do not stay in Thailand beyond the **ADMITTED UNTIL** date as stamped in the applicant's passport.

Please note that passport holders of the following countries must apply for their visa in person only at the Royal Thai Embassy, London:

Afghanistan, Algeria, Bangladesh, Cambodia, Cameroon, Central African Republic, China, Congo (Democratic Republic), Congo (Republic), Egypt, Equatorial Guinea, Ghana, Guinea, India, Iran, Iraq, Kosovo, Lebanon, Liberia, Libya, Nepal, Nigeria, North Korea, Pakistan, Palestine, Sao Tome & Principe, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Sri Lanka, Sudan, Syria, Yemen.
