## **YELLOW FEVER & MALARIA**

A valid 'Yellow Fever' vaccination certificate is required for all persons entering Thailand from countries with the risk of Yellow Fever transmission, including persons transiting through airports of countries with Yellow Fever transmission risk.

Also note that there is a Malaria risk throughout the year in rural, especially forested and hilly areas of Thailand mainly towards the international borders, including the southern provinces.

There should be no risk in the major cities and main tourist resorts, however, there is a risk on some of the islands.
